

Minutes Anti-Bullying Committee
November 27, 2006

The meeting was held in Dr Carnahan's office at 7 PM.

Presented for review were the results from most of the parent surveys collected so far. The results will be completed and presented separated by school for the committee's evaluation.

The results from the high school survey monkey q'naires were also examined. Among the comments were how many more people had seen bullying than had experienced it; that the classroom, halls, buses and "somewhere else" were hot spots for teasing and name-calling; the lunchroom for spreading rumors; the gym and after-school activities for being left out; the parking lot/schoolyard fro inappropriate touch; the hall for injury; and the lunch for having had money taken, and that most witnesses did nothing.
