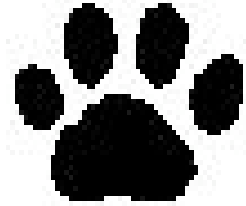

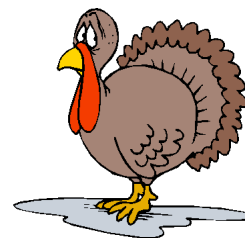

“PAWS”itive Things Happening at MVHS

As the newness of the 2008-09 school year has begun to wear off, PAWS are continuing their commitment to making a difference at MVHS. Thanks in large part to the PAW freshman orientation program, the new freshmen seem to be right at home Medomak. PAWS also have assisted a number of transfer students as they get acclimated to a new school.

In November PAWS have dedicated time to community service at the craft fair held at MVHS on 11/15 to benefit the Waldoboro Public Library. They will also be conducting an anti-bullying workshop at Miller School on November 21, and are eager to start serving as mentors to Medomak Middle School students. Additionally, more than a dozen PAWS have volunteered (giving up study hall time and PAT time) to be tutors in a variety of academic subjects, both one-on-one and as part of a drop-in, quick-fix tutoring clinic, to start weekly in December.

Plans are also well underway for upcoming Spirit Week, sponsored by PAWS, to be held 12/8-12/12, culminating in a pep rally for winter sport athletes on Friday, the 12th, period 4. PAWS sponsor Spirit Week to foster school spirit and pride through a variety of ways. Classes compete for points as part of theme dress-up days, hall decorating, a twin day parade (and competition), pep rally activities, etc. For each of the theme dress-up days, students must wear at least two items related to the theme. Monday, 12/8 is PJ Day; Tuesday, 12/9 is Mismatch or Opposite Day; Wednesday, 12/10 is Twin Day (parade in the gym); Thursday, 12/11 is Costume Day; and Friday, 12/12 is School Colors Day. PAWS will be baking cookies for the whole school that week, and Thursday classes will stay after to decorate their halls to show school spirit and unity. The winning class will receive a monetary donation to their coffers from the office.
