REGISTRATION OPENS FOR WALDOBORO YOUTH SOCCER

Registrations for Waldoboro Youth Soccer will be accepted in the Recreation Department at the Waldoboro Town Office Mon-Fri 8:30-5pm until Sept. 7th.

A "last chance" registration session will be held at Medomak Valley High School (near the baseball field) on Saturday September 8th, 2007. Players in the 5th and 6th grade are encouraged to register as soon as possible in order to get the travel team together.

The Waldoboro Soccer program is open to boys and girls entering Kindergarten through 6th grade in Waldoboro and all surrounding communities. Cost of the program is \$20.00 per player. There are three divisions of play: MICRO's (K-2), PEEWEE's - (3rd/4th) and JUNIORS's (5th/6th). MICROS & PEEWEE's will play Saturday's beginning Sept. 15th. JUNIORS will play in the Midcoast Travel League beginning Sept. 18th.
