

Rules of Order

All meetings will be conducted by Robert's Rules of Order, Newly Revised, except where otherwise noted in policy.

Quorum

A quorum of the Board will consist of a majority of the Directors in number and voting power. No business may be transacted at any meeting unless a quorum is present, except that a minority of the Board may adjourn the meeting until a quorum is present.

Voting

When a quorum is present, a majority vote, i.e., a majority of the votes cast, ignoring abstentions, is sufficient for the adoption of any motion that is in order, except those that require a 2/3 vote. Voting will be by a show of hands. Each member's vote or failure to vote (abstention) will be recorded in the minutes.

Board Chair

As a full member of the assembly, the Board Chair has the same right to vote, make motions and participate in debate as any other member.

The Chair is vested with the authority to interpret Robert's Rules of Order and make their application to procedural issues of any meeting. The Chair is also responsible for the orderly conduct of the meeting and will rule on such matters as the appropriateness of the subject being presented and the suitability of the time for such a presentation.

Appealing the Chair

Any member may make a non-debatable appeal from any ruling of the Chair (except when another appeal is pending), but it can be made only at the time the ruling is made. The member making the appeal will give reason(s) for the appeal after which the Board will, by a majority vote, either sustain or overrule the Chair.

Open Meeting Rule

All meetings of the Board, except authorized executive sessions, will be open to the public. All actions of the Board will be taken openly. The public and district employees are encouraged to attend Board meetings and will be given time to voice opinions or concerns (see Board Policy BEDH).
