

Programs for Students with Limited English Proficiency

RSU 40 will provide appropriate programs for English learners to assist them in attaining English language proficiency and meeting state and local academic achievement standards in compliance with applicable federal and state requirements. RSU 40 will also provide opportunities for parent involvement in their children's education as required by federal law.

The Superintendent is responsible for developing and implementing the school unit's Lau Plan and any necessary administrative procedures. The Superintendent may delegate specific responsibilities to building administrators or others as deemed appropriate.

The Lau plan, along with all necessary procedures and subsequent revisions, must be approved by the Board of Directors.
