

## **CARE OF SCHOOL PROPERTY BY STUDENTS**

Textbooks, other school property, and facilities are available to students for their use. Each student is responsible for loss or damage beyond normal wear. Parents/guardians of students will be billed for the repair of school facilities or the replacement costs of lost, destroyed, or damaged materials.

If reimbursement is not forthcoming within a reasonable time:

A. If the replacement cost of lost, destroyed, or damaged school books or instructional equipment is not reimbursed within 45 working days of parental notification, the Board may report the amount to the municipal assessor for the purpose of including the replacement cost in the next municipal tax of the delinquent parent.

B. Damage to school property may be recovered in a civil action to obtain the permitted “double the damage;”

C. Acts of vandalism may result in criminal charges.

The Superintendent shall see that students and parents are notified annually of their responsibilities under this policy, such as by publication in student/parent handbooks.
