

### **Reintegration of Students from Juvenile Correctional Facilities**

The Superintendent must comply with applicable state laws and standards of the Maine Department of Education when a student enters a public school from a juvenile correctional facility, including the establishment of a reintegration team to assist the student.

The Superintendent will be responsible for determining whether a student will be accepted or denied access to school based on compliance with conditions of the juvenile's rehabilitation plan that are relevant to the student's reintegration into school. Access may be denied until the Superintendent is satisfied that conditions have been met.

The Superintendent will develop administrative procedures necessary to comply with the legal requirements. The Superintendent will also ensure that appropriate confidentiality training concerning students' juvenile justice and educational records is provided to school employees who have access to such information. The Superintendent may delegate specific responsibilities to administrators or others, as the Superintendent deems appropriate.
