PARKING LOT RULES
2018-2019

The driver of the vehicle they are operating is **responsible for anything** that takes place concerning that vehicle. Bringing a vehicle on school grounds is a **privilege** granted to students. Since all SAD #40 students have access to busses, driving your own vehicle is a **privilege that can be revoked**. The school administration has a responsibility to ensure the safety of all members of the MVHS community from irresponsible and careless behavior of vehicle operators.

1. Students must park in the authorized areas only.
 - The Student Parking Area is in front of the school, just to the right of the student drop-off/pick-up area, directly in front of the science wing.
2. All student vehicles parking on school grounds must be registered with the school. To obtain a parking permit, you must complete and return the registration forms and show proof of registration, insurance and valid driver's license. Students that receive a parking permit (\$10.00 fee) must display it on the passenger side lower front windshield. If you alternate between vehicles that you bring to school on a regular basis, both of the vehicles will need to be registered. If you bring a different vehicle just once or twice, please let the office staff know what type of vehicle and the plate #.
Failure to register a vehicle will result in the loss of parking privileges.
3. The speed limit on school grounds is **10 miles per hour**.
4. Passing a school bus with its lights flashing will result in action by law enforcement and loss of privileges.
5. Power turns, squealing of tires or other dangerous maneuvers with a vehicle will not be tolerated.
6. Once you enter the school grounds, you are expected to park your vehicle in the student parking lot, and enter the school building.

There will be **no loitering** in the parking lot area. You are expected to remain at the school all day unless you are excused and have signed out in with the attendance office.

7. In the winter, when ice and snow are in the driveways, students are expected to keep their vehicle under control and obey all traffic rules and speed limits.
8. All no parking signs, one-way signs and stop signs are to be obeyed.
9. All school rules, including smoking regulations, also apply to the parking lots.
10. Trips to the parking lot during school hours will be discouraged. Your vehicle is not your locker. Be sure to bring everything needed for the day into the building when you enter in the morning. It will be up to the administration to determine if a trip to the parking lot is necessary. Students **must** receive a pass from an administrator specifying the purpose of a trip to the parking lot during the school day. The student **must** check in with the office before leaving the building **and again upon reentering**.
11. Any violation of school rules involving your car such as smoking, carrying drugs or alcohol, aiding or permitting other students or yourself to skip classes, tardiness, parking violations or other violations, will result in the loss of the privilege to drive a vehicle to school.
12. Any driver who violated the law will be referred to the School Resource Officer and or law enforcement for action.
13. Students who ignore the suspensions of parking privileges will be subject to disciplinary action from the school administration.
14. Vehicles on school property may be searched by the administration, School Resource Officer, and/or law enforcement officials when there are reasonable grounds to suspect that the search will turn up evidence that a school policy has been violated (i.e. chemical health policy, weapons policy).
15. Vehicles parked in unauthorized areas are subject to be towed at the owner's expense and parking privileges may be suspended for the remainder of the year.
